Turning Points: Art for Survivors

WCA/NH is partnering with Turning Points Network of Sullivan County, a private, non-profit agency offering free and confidential crisis and support services to survivors, their friends, loved ones, service providers and concerned community members impacted by domestic violence, sexual violence and stalking.

Artists of all mediums are invited to submit work that speaks to the trauma of, and recovery from, domestic and sexual violence.

The exploitation of power and control are the hallmark of abuse. Submissions depicting the physical, emotional and spiritual wounds of violation as well as the courage and empowerment of surviving it are welcome.

This is a powerful opportunity to use your art to celebrate the strides of social awareness that have been made, along with giving voice to still greater aspirations.

Any WCA/NH profits from this exhibit will be donated to Turning Points Network.

Eligibility: Open to all current and past WCA/NH members

Artwork Specifications: Artists may submit up to three works, 2-d or 3-d. All mediums accepted. Maximum size: 16 square feet.

Entry fee: \$25 for up to three works for WCA/NH members;
\$35 for up to three works for past members of WCA/NH.

Exhibition Sales Terms: Gallery will sell work. Commission for the Library Arts Center is 30%.

Insurance: All work is insured by the Library Arts Center while hanging in the gallery: 70% of each piece, up to \$2,500 per piece.

Presentation: Work must be suitably prepared and ready for presentation. Wall-mounted work must be properly wired for hanging. Work not suitably prepared will not be shown. Please affix labels with name, title and price to the back of the artwork. Pedestals are available for 3-d work.

Drop off: August 30 & 31, 11 am - 4pm, or by appointment.

Pick up: October 14, 11am - 4 pm & October 15, 10am – noon.

Artist Statement: Please submit to Exhibitions Coordinator, Lisa Almeida lisaann.loomgart@gmail.com a short artist statement explaining the meaning behind your work to be included in a notebook during show. Please email Lisa by September 1st.
